METAL AND APPLIANCES

- Stoves, Washing machines
- Bed frames
- Bikes

- Open, dry drums
- Non PCB Balasts
- Empty and dry fuel tanks

All concrete bases removed from metal posts

REFRIGERANT UNITS

• Fridges, Freezers, AC Units , Dehumidifiers, Water Coolers *Empty of all food waste, Stand up neatly in rows*

WIRE

- Wire rope and cable less than 3 feet in length
- Page wire, Barbed wire, Chain link fence, Welded fence, Plastic-coated wire netting

no privacy slats, wood posts or concrete pole bases

TIRES

- Car and light truck tires
- Medium truck tires
- Bike tires

Specialty, Industrial and other Tires with a rim diameter of 8" up to and including 24" such as trailer tires e.g. boat, recreation, travel, motorcycle

CONSTRUCTION / DEMOLITION

- Concrete & Asphalt
- Trees & Branches

ALL Fence Posts Removed

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS Must be Clean and Segregated

MIXED PAPER

- Flattened Food and Shoe boxes
- Newspaper, Flyers, Magazines
- Office and Shredded Paper
- Paper Bags

TIN CANS

• Tin and Aluminum food cans

#1-7 RIDGED PLASTIC No Plastic Bags

- Shampoo bottles, Laundry detergent & bleach
- Yogurt, margarine and food containers
- Clam shells
- Plastic utensils
- Ice cream pails
- Windshield washer and Antifreeze containers

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

• Flattened cardboard only

All Styrofoam and Packaging is Garbage

GOODWILL CLOTHING BIN

• Gently used, clean and dry clothing and textiles

GLASS FOOD JARS

USED VEGETABLE OIL

LANDFILL *Any residual waste goes to landfill* Loads going to landfill include:

• Residual residential waste including furniture, mattresses, and common household items like bathroom waste, soiled and dirty linens, kitty litter, pet waste, sod, plastic bags and plastic film

 Construction/demolition/renovation waste including decks, vinyl siding, insulation & drywall, toilets, and cabinets

- 1 Food waste (vegetables, fruits, meat products, dairy, grains, baked goods, coffee grounds)
- 2 Food contaminated paper (pizza boxes, papertowels, napkins)
- 3 Compostable food service ware
- 4 Leaf and Yard Waste (vegetative matter from gardening, horticulture, agriculture, landscaping)

HERE ARE FIVE ITEMS TO LINE YOUR ORGANICS BIN WITHOUT PLASTIC BAGS

- Newspaper
- Cardboard box
- Shredded paper
- Paper bag
