

Year-Round HSP Program - Starting April 1, 2025

Roseridge is expanding its **Hazardous Special Products (HSP)** disposal options to help residents safely remove hazardous materials from their homes. Beginning April 1, 2025, residents can drop off specific household hazardous materials year-round at both Roseridge facilities.

Know Your Labels - The Key to Proper Disposal

Understanding hazardous waste labels is essential for ensuring safe and effective disposal.

CCCR Symbols (Octagon or Inverted Triangle)

Most items with CCCR labels are accepted year-round, but some require special handling—see restrictions below.

WHMIS & TDG Symbols (Red Diamond or Circle)

These are only accepted at HHW Round-Ups

Always check the label before disposal! If your item has a CCCR label, you can bring it to Roseridge anytime. If it has a WHMIS or TDG label, hold onto it for an HHW Round-Up Event.

What is HSP?

Hazardous Special Products (HSP) include household chemicals and materials that pose potential risks to health and the environment. These materials require unique disposal methods to prevent contamination of landfills, water sources, and ecosystems.

Accepted Year-Round HSP Items

Roseridge now accepts the following HSP items at any time:

Consumer Chemical Containers (must display a Consumer Chemicals and Containers Regulations (CCCR) symbol)

Corrosive, Flammable, or Toxic Products (solid or liquid, up to 10kg or 10L in volume)

Pressurized Gas Containers (non-refillable cylinders up to 680g)

Domestic Pesticides (must be labeled "DANGER" or "WARNING")

Examples of Accepted Items:

- ✓ **Household cleaners:** Oven cleaner, silver polish, rust removers
- ✓ **Flammable liquids:** Camping fuel, gasoline (≤25L), lighter fluid
- ✓ **Toxic products:** Tar remover, automotive additives
- ✓ **Pressurized gas cylinders:** Non-refillable butane, propane, MAPP gas
- ✓ **Pesticides:** Aerosol and liquid domestic-use pesticides



Not Accepted in the Year-Round HSP Program

These items are only accepted during our Biannual Recycling Roundups:

- ✗ **Personal-use insect repellents:** Bug spray, DEET-based products
- ✗ **Disinfectants, bleach, and drain cleaners:** Intended for down-the-drain use
- ✗ **Non-Hazardous Aerosols:** Hairspray, cooking spray, air fresheners
- ✗ **Mercury-containing items:** Thermometers, thermostats
- ✗ **Fertilizers, herbicides, and restricted pesticides**
- ✗ **Automotive fluids and pool chemicals**
- ✗ **Explosives, fireworks, flares**
- ✗ **Unlabeled or unknown chemicals**
- ✗ **Additional exclusions:** Ant traps, antimicrobial products, insecticidal soaps, sanitizers, butane lighters, CO2 cartridges

For items not accepted year-round, bring them to one of our HHW Round-Up Events:

Final Notes for Residents:

Always read labels carefully to determine whether an item can be **dropped off year-round** or must wait for an **HHW Round-Up**. Use products as intended before disposal whenever possible. Never dump hazardous waste in landfills, storm drains, or household trash.
