

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING IS EXPANDING NEW TO THE BLUE

Beginning Oct. 1, more types of residential packaging and paper products will be accepted for recycling.

WHAT IS BEING ADDED?

Flexible plastic packaging

Bread bags, chip and snack bags, coffee bags, deli pouches, cereal liners, bubble wrap and the plastic overwrap around cases of water, toilet paper and paper towels.

Foam packaging

Meat trays, takeout containers, foam cups, plates, bowls and protective foam packaging.

Empty aerosol containers

Food spray, hairspray, air freshener, shaving cream and deodorant containers.

Laminated paper packaging

Pet food bags, paper cups and plates, spiral chip tubes, ice cream containers, soup and stock cartons, and other paper packaging with a plastic or foil lining.

Glass containers

Clear and coloured food jars and bottles.

Other items already accepted

Paper, corrugated cardboard, cartons, clamshells and other plastic containers, metal cans, aluminum foil and trays will continue to be accepted.



BRINGING RECYCLING TO ROSERIDGE

Accepted packaging and paper materials can be brought in commercially available translucent blue recycling bags, or your own reusable containers. Materials do not need to be separated by type.

GET IT READY

- Empty packaging and containers and remove food residue.
- Flatten cardboard and boxboard to no larger than 60 × 60 cm (24 × 24 in.).
- Leave lids and caps on clean, empty cartons, plastic containers and aerosol containers.
- Remove lids and caps from glass and paper-based containers.
- Remove film and absorbent pads from foam meat trays.
- Place shredded paper in a tied clear plastic bag.
- Please do not include hardcover or softcover books. Donate them to your local thrift store.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Extended Producer Responsibility is regulated by the Government of Alberta. Circular Materials coordinates Alberta's residential packaging and paper products recycling program, and Roseridge facilities serve as depot collection points.
