## BEFORE YOU VISIT

### Bring Your Permit Card

Residents of Roseridge member municipalities require a physical residential permit card to access the facility. Permit cards are available through your municipality.

### Minimum Load Charge

A minimum charge applies to each mixed waste load.  
Loads containing only accepted recycling are not charged.

### Secure Your Load

All loads must be properly secured before travelling to Roseridge.

# WHAT CAN YOU BRING TO THE TRANSFER STATION?

The Roseridge Transfer Station provides several options to recycle and dispose of household waste. Please keep materials separated where possible and follow signs or staff directions to the appropriate drop-off area.

## Household Recycling

Bring household packaging and paper products, electronics, paint, tires, batteries, used oil materials, Hazardous & Special Products and eligible agricultural recycling to the designated areas.

## Resource Recovery

Separate drop-off areas are available for:

- Scrap Metal & Wire
- Brush & Branches

**PLEASE NOTE:** Asphalt & concrete and refrigerant appliances are not accepted at the Redwater Transfer Station. These materials must be taken to the Roseridge Waste Management Center.

## Household Waste

Regular household garbage and other accepted non-recyclable materials can be brought to the Transfer Station and placed in the household waste bins.

## NOT ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER STATION

Because the Transfer Station has limited handling capacity, the following materials must be taken to the Roseridge Waste Management Center:

- Large furniture and mattresses
- Shingles
- Automotive batteries
- Animal carcasses
- Railway ties
- Asphalt & concrete
- Refrigerant appliances
