BEFORE YOU VISIT

Bring Your Permit Card

Residents of Roseridge member municipalities require a physical residential permit card to access the facility. Permit cards are available through your municipality.

Minimum Load Charge

A 125 kg minimum charge applies to waste disposal. Loads weighing less than 125 kg are charged at the minimum rate.

Secure Your Load

All loads must be properly secured before travelling to Roseridge.

WHAT CAN YOU BRING TO ROSERIDGE?

The Roseridge Waste Management Center provides several options to recycle, recover, compost and reuse materials, helping keep recoverable resources out of landfill. Keep materials separated where possible and follow signs or staff directions to the appropriate drop-off area.

Household Recycling

Bring household packaging and paper products, electronics, paint, tires, batteries, used oil materials, Hazardous & Special Products and eligible agricultural recycling to the designated areas.

Resource Recovery

Separate drop-off areas are available for:

- Asphalt & Concrete
- Scrap Metal & Wire
- Refrigerant Appliances
- Brush & Branches

Refrigerant Appliance rates:

Fridges, freezers, air conditioners and water coolers: \$20 per item; RV fridges: \$35 per item

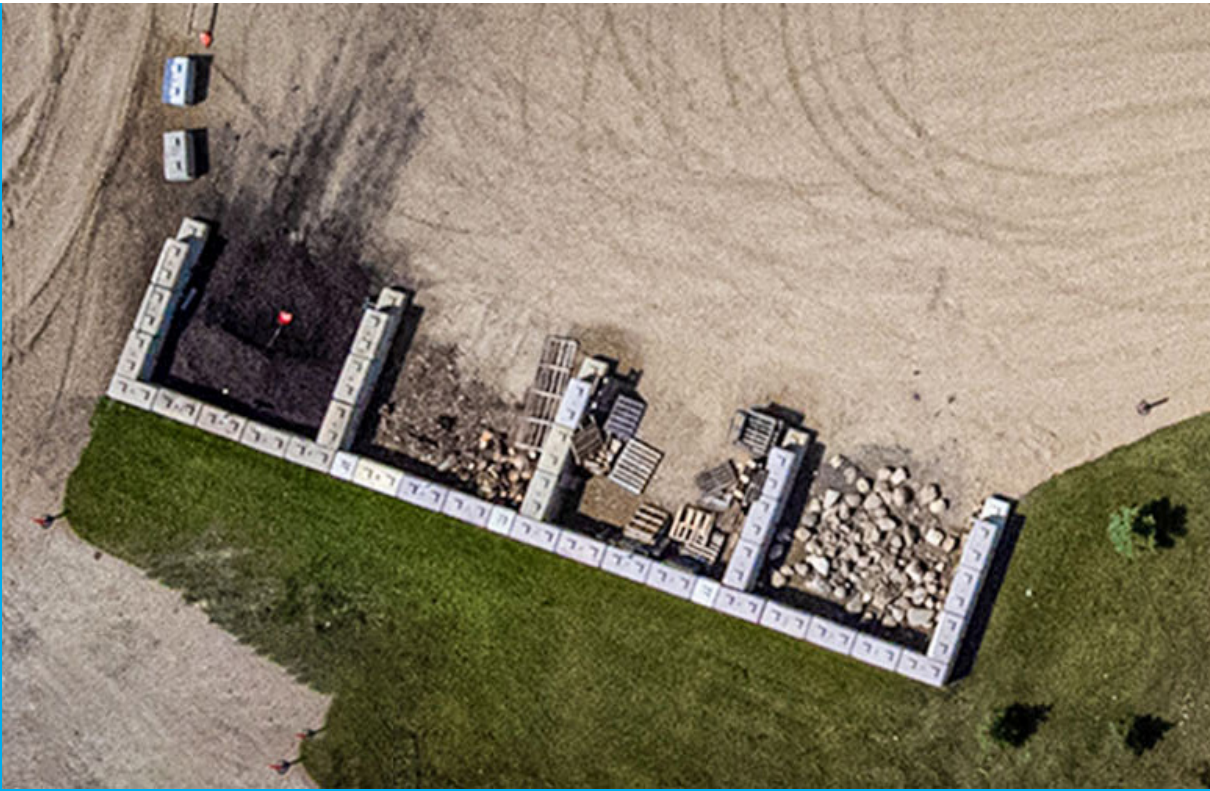
Community Resource Zone
