Accepted Materials

FOOD SCRAPS

- Fruits and vegetables
- Milk, yogurt, and cheese
- Bread and baked goods
- Dry goods like pasta, rice, and cereal
- Coffee grounds and filters
- Tea bags
- Meat, fish & poultry
- Eggs and eggshells
- Corn cobs and husks
- Jams, jellies, and sauces
- Nuts and nut shells
- Table scraps, salads

LEAF & YARD WASTE

- Houseplant trimmings
- Leaves
- Grass clippings
- Wood chips
- Hay, straw
- Dead plants/flowers
- Sawdust & wood chips

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS & PAPER

- Napkins, paper towel
- Compostable food tray and utensils
- Used paper plates
- Paper bags

🚫 ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ACCEPTED 🚫

FOOD SCRAPS & PACKAGING ❌ 🍔

- Takeout drink cups – *Garbage*
- Clean and dry butcher paper wrap – *Recycle*
- Microwave popcorn bags – *Garbage*
- Frozen food boxes – *Recycle*
- Glossy paper – *Recycle*
- Grease or oil – *Garbage*
- Food packaging – *Garbage*
- Fruit and vegetable stickers – *Garbage*

HOUSEHOLD WASTE ❌ 🏠

- Diapers and sanitary products – *Garbage*
- Dryer sheets – *Garbage*
- Dryer lint – *Garbage*
- Cotton balls – *Garbage*
- Vacuum cleaner bags – *Garbage*
- Kitty litter – *Garbage*
- Clothing or fabric – *Garbage*
- Styrofoam – *Garbage*
- Cereal box liners – *Garbage*

YARD WASTE & ORGANICS ❌ 🌳

- Animal waste and litter – *Garbage*
- Treated wood – *Garbage*
- Noxious weeds – *Garbage*
- Diseased plant material – *Garbage*
- Plant pots and bedding trays – *Recycle*
